How the Program Works

Adventure Guides offers father/daughter and father/son expeditions for kids ages 5-12. Unlike drop-off programs, each outing is attended by both father and child. The program enables parent and child to share new adventures, explore nature, and create memories that will last two lifetimes.

Events

Event can be day, overnight, or weekend trips and include: Catalina, Joshua Tree, Winter Camp, Camp Surf, Roar n Snore, Magic Castle, and Sleepover at Angel Stadium, plus service learning projects, monthly gatherings and much more! Attendance at all events is not required. Attend all or attend a few.

Compass Program

The Compass Program allows guides to participate in fun and challenging activities outside of meetings and events, offering more one-on-one time for parent and child.

Federation



Federations are a group of Expeditions within a region.

Expedition



Expeditions are groups of Circles organized by gender (i.e. dad/daughter). Typically an Expedition is made up of 4-10 Circles.

Circle



Circles are a group of Guides & Explorers. Typically Circles are made up of 5-12 families within a school or neighborhood, but not necessarily.

Explorer & Guide



These are the names for parents and children. Each person (dad & child) chooses an Adventure Guide name when joining the program.
