



Creative Writing & Publishing, Magazine (ELA): Create your own magazine! From writing articles to designing layouts, this class teaches you everything about publishing. Express your ideas and share them with the world in your unique magazine.

Digital Literacy/Storytelling (ELA): Step into the digital age with our exciting storytelling class! Use digital tools to create animations, stories, and designs. This class is for all students, no tech experience required. Perfect for tech-savvy kids who love to blend creativity with technology.

Drones for Kids: This program offers a comprehensive introduction to drone technology, focusing on both the technical and practical aspects of drone operation. Students will learn how to fly, race and even build a drone!

Elective Sampler: Not sure which elective to take because you love them all? The Elective Sampler offers a little bit of everything. You will explore creative, hands-on activities in science, sewing, cooking, and more! We start the session with our most popular classes, but this class is the most student-led and interest-based, as students help to choose upcoming lessons and themes.

Engineering & Maker Space: Become a young engineer! This hands-on class lets you design, build, and test cool projects. From bridges to windmills, discover the fun of making and the science behind it all.

Engineering & Makerspace Mario Kart Live Home Circuit: Combine the excitement of Mario Kart with the creativity of a makerspace! Design and build your own race tracks, then test them out with Mario Kart Live. Perfect for kids who love gaming and engineering.

Home Economics: Learn essential life skills in a fun and engaging way! From cooking quick meals to sewing and managing finances, this class prepares you for everyday life with practical and useful knowledge.

Keeping Fit PE: Stay active and healthy with fun group games, fitness activities, and purposeful play. Enjoy social time while building healthy habits related to eating and physical activity. Perfect for kids who love to move and play.

Kulinary Kids: Calling all young chefs! Explore the world of cooking with hands-on activities that engage all your senses. Learn to make delicious dishes while improving your motor skills and having a blast in the kitchen.

Lunch Bunch/Social: Take a break and enjoy lunch with friends! This social hour is filled with fun team-building activities and games that promote friendship and community. Bring your lunch and join us for a delightful social experience.

Math LEGO: Love LEGOs and math? Combine the two in this fun and interactive class! Solve math challenges and build amazing LEGO creations. Perfect for kids who enjoy hands-on learning and creative problem-solving.

Science: Discover the wonders of science with hands-on experiments and exciting projects! From exploring nature to conducting cool experiments, this class makes learning science fun and engaging. Includes paper circuit challenges, where students create simple electronic circuits using paper, conductive tape, and small electronic components to bring their projects to life.

Sign Language & Deaf Culture: Learn a new language and explore a vibrant culture! This class teaches you American Sign Language and the rich cultural aspects of the Deaf community. A wonderful way to enhance communication skills and cultural awareness.

Strategic Games: Math: Make math fun through interactive games and hands-on challenges! This class turns math into an exciting adventure, where students solve puzzles, play games, and tackle engaging activities that enhance their problem-solving skills. Perfect for kids who enjoy dynamic and playful learning.

Test Prep/Academic Support: Get the support you need to excel in your studies! This class offers help in various subjects, ensuring you have the resources and guidance to succeed academically. Ideal for students looking to boost their knowledge and skills.

Twisted Stitches: Get creative with sewing and crocheting! Learn the techniques and craft your own designs. This class is perfect for those who love working with their hands and creating unique pieces.

Beyond The Elective

Community Events: Throughout the year, we will host community events for homeschool families to come together to celebrate, educate, and build relationships. Come see our maker's markets, vendor events, resource fairs, and more.

Family Field Trips: Each 13-session registration includes free admission for one child and one adult to attend our family field trip for that session. Additional tickets can be purchased at cost.

Monthly Park Days in Fullerton: Families come together for park day play. Most meet-ups are free (or have a small material fee) and include a craft or hands-on activity for the entire family.

There are no age requirements for this meet-up. However, parents must stay with their child and support the activities.

Monthly Social Events in Mission Viejo: Two-hour drop-off events for students to come together to socialize and experience hands-on activities. Most socials will include a craft and a cooking component.

Prepared Parent: Adult socials! Parents get together to craft, curriculum-swap, share best practices, and discuss all things "homeschool".

Ballet: Our dance classes are designed to be age-appropriate and to teach youth dance techniques and routines by skilled dance instructors. Children in ballet class must wear ballet slippers. End of session performance TBA.

Youth Basketball Class: Youth Basketball Class is intended for all youth ability levels. The beginner class will focus on the development of fundamental basketball skills. Participants will learn basic building blocks such as footwork, dribbling, shooting, and passing. Intermediate is for kids who want to take their game to the next level by enhancing skills by introducing them to high-level basketball drills. Advanced will engage in competition in a fun and supportive environment that emphasizes character development and participate in 30 min of practice/drills and 30 min of casual scrimmage.

Youth Basketball League: Youth Basketball leagues are offered for children and youth. Through the league, they will learn the fundamentals of the sport (i.e., ball handling, shooting, passing, defense) and engage in competition with local teams in a fun and supportive environment that emphasizes character development, teamwork, and good sportsmanship. Assessment is required. The in-season clinic is offered. Jersey cost is included in the fee.

Youth Cheerleading: Teach your child the basics of cheerleading with cheers, dances, and the opportunity to cheer at YMCA league games. Uniforms are \$50 and will be ordered the first week of practice

Youth Flag Football League: Is your child ready for team play? Our leagues put your child in the game with children their age and skill level, as they learn sportsmanship, develop skills, and gain a sense of accomplishment, no matter the outcome of the game. Children will learn the fundamentals of the sport and engage in a fun and supportive environment that emphasizes character development, teamwork, and good sportsmanship.

Youth Gymnastics: Beginning students will gain strength and flexibility as they learn the basics of gymnastics. They will develop the skills of tumbling including rolls, handstands, back bridges, and cartwheels. Advanced students will continue to develop strength and flexibility as they build on the fundamentals of gymnastics. They will continue to work on the basic skills of tumbling and will be introduced to round-offs, headstands, and front/back walkovers.

Youth Lacrosse: Partnered with Kids Lacrosse LLC offering a clinic options for kids ages 3-6 or ages 7-14 to learn the fundamentals of Lacrosse. The clinics will be held once a week for 5 weeks.

Youth Martial Arts: Our martial arts program gives students a chance to learn some of the basic elements that Muay Thai, Kick Boxing, Brazilian Jiu Jitsu, and wrestling have to offer. This program will help kids not only become more engaged in physical activity but also helps teach them self-defense techniques while getting into shape.

Youth Soccer Class: Classes will focus on the development of fundamental skills and the growth of your child in our 4 core values: caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. Participants will learn the basic building blocks for success in a fun environment.

Youth Soccer League: Youth Soccer leagues are offered for children and youth. Through the league, they will learn the fundamentals of the sport (i.e., kicking, dribbling, passing, defense) and engage in competition with local teams in a fun and supportive environment that emphasizes character development, teamwork, and good sportsmanship. Assessment is required. The in-season clinic is offered. Jersey cost is included in the fee.

Youth Swim Lessons: Group swim lessons are offered year-round and are broken down into eight levels based on ability. Each level is taught with a specific instructor/student ratio. We offer lessons twice a week (Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday), or once a week on Saturdays.

Youth T-Ball League: At the Y, PreK Tball League participants will learn the sport and will play against each other on teams. Team t-shirt is included in the program fee

Youth Volleyball League: Youth Volleyball Leagues are offered for youth. Youth will learn the fundamentals of the sport (serving, passing, defense) and engage in competition with local teams in a fun and supportive environment that emphasizes character development, teamwork, and good sportsmanship. Assessment is required. The in-season clinic is offered. Jersey cost is included in the fee.


