Expeditions are groups of Circles organized by gender (i.e. dad/ daughter). Typically an Expedition is made up of 4-10 Circles within the local communities.







Circles are a group of dads & sons or daughters. Typically Circles are made up of 5 or more families within a school or neighborhood, but not necessarily. Many families join Circles with work friends or sports friends.
